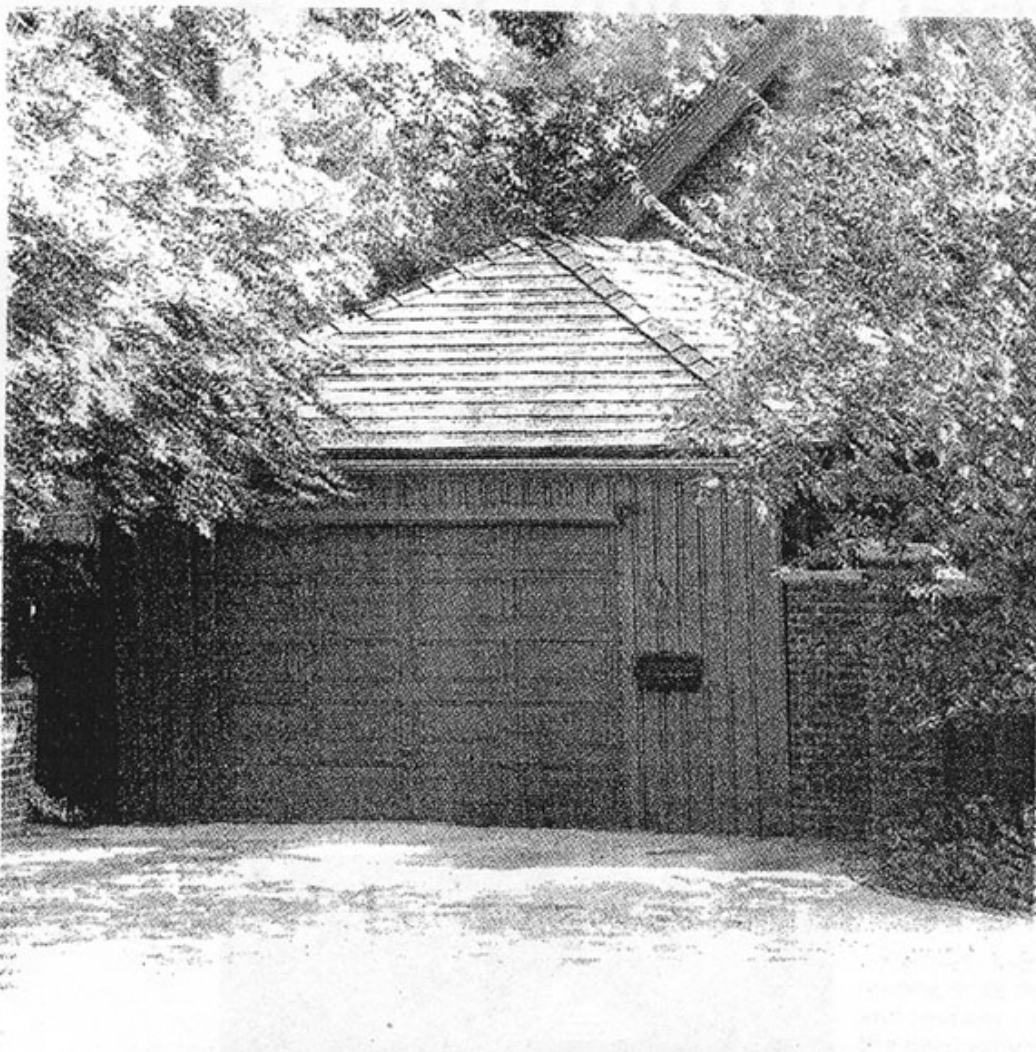

Need a garage?

Pre-fab houses have been around for decades, and a lot of places sell pre-fabricated backyard sheds, where you buy the kits and piece them together yourself. Now come pre-fab garages, from a Canadian company using natural cedar siding or 14 colors of maintenance-free Canoxel siding to make 1- and 2-car garages in several sizes and shapes. Summerwood, founded 15 years ago by Peter Harvey, is also the word for the summer growth rings in a tree trunk. Prices for the kits range from \$10,795 for a single-car model, to \$39,495 for a large, two-car model, not including assembly, wiring, insulation or other interior matters. Several types of doors and windows are available. We haven't seen one of these up close, but the catalog and website are alluring. If you're considering a new garage, and pre-fab sounds interesting, Summerwood might be worth a look. (The catalog and website also include photographs and information on sheds.)
